5. Approval of Previous Minutes: Minutes approved. Lindsay motioned, Radtke seconded. All in favor.

6. Recreation Department Report:

- Tai Chi and Zumba/Zumba Gold, and Beginners Yoga are all doing well. Keeping Food Scraps Out of Landfill class went well and the Recreation Department plans to hold another class like it this summer.
- Ice Out Tickets are being sold online, at Frey Family Deli & Convenience, Raj Liquor & Beverage, and at the Recreation Office. Over 33 tickets have been sold, and will sell until April 1.
- Annual Youth Sports Organization Meeting will be held on March 23.
- Milton Recreation Master Plan Update has been completed and is available online.
- Egg Hunt will be on April 11. Scouts will stuff the eggs in advance.
- Summer Camp registrations are going well. Camp counselors are being recruited. Quite a few people have applied.
- Park Spruce Up Day is April 18.
- Music in the Park will begin on June 2. Matt Mullen has made a \$1200 donation and will be the food vendor at these concerts. \$1000 of the Recreation Budget will be used toward the performances. Performers will include Starline Rhythm Boys; Hitmen; Lebowski Trio and more.
- The Fourth of July parade will be at 11 am; with an afternoon BBQ. In the evening, there will be a DJ, food vendors and fireworks.
- Construction in Milton Municipal Building is scheduled to be completed by March 20.
- The Milton Dog Park was closed at the end of February due to mud. Commissioners discussed the possibility of opening only the smaller section, which has more light and will dry up sooner, to dog owners around April 1. There is concern that dog owners are using the sports fields for their dogs to run.
- The Spring & Summer Milton Recreation Guide will be come out on April 16.
- Green Up Day will be on May 2. Volunteers are needed.

7. Recreation Commission Report:

- Giant Pumpkin Competition will have donations of seeds donated by Oliver Seed. Contact will be made to the Milton Farmers Market about holding the finale there in October. The manager of the Farmer's Market has left, so we need to find out who is now in charge.
- There will be joint meeting of the Milton Conservation Commission and Recreation Commission sometime this spring.

- Recreation Commissioners were given packets of info for commissioners. A group picture will be taken in April to be posted on the Recreation Commission webpage.


