#### Milton Rescue Department

For the week ending 05/05/2019 the ambulance service responded to \_ calls for service. The year to date total number of incidents is 20 calls for service.

Despite the return of warm weather the rescue and fire departments responded to multiple motor vehicle crashes. Even with snow off the roads the risk of high speeds and distracted driving is real.

May 18<sup>th</sup> the Rescue Department will host their 5th Annual Health & Safety Fair. This is partnership with the Milton Police Department and local businesses. Fun activities, such as a bike rodeo, rescue station tours, hands only CPR instruction, and care seat safety inspections will happen from 11-2pm at the Milton Municipal Building complex and the rescue station. #### Milton Fire Department

For the week ending 05/05/2019 the fire service has responded to 5 calls for service. On May 19<sup>th</sup> the Milton Fire Department will engage in a live burn training exercise utilizing the Milton Town School Districts property on Bradley Street.
