### Weekly Report Ending 06/30/2019

#### Milton Rescue Department

The last week of FY'19 brought 24 calls for ambulance service resulting in 21 transports. Halfway through the calendar year Rescue has responded to 468 calls for service and resulting in a transport rate of approximately 60 percent. Based on end of year transport trends and changes in weather we anticipate responding to more than 1,000 calls by the New Year.

Ambulance 2 has returned from the shop after undergoing an \$11,000 turbo system and exhaust repair. Following its return Ambulance 1 was sent to the shop for a quick repair on the patient compartment air conditioning system.

Over the weekend Joe Gannon, Advanced EMT, taught a group of residents CPR and AED skills in the fire department training room. Public classes are taught twice per quarter and individuals can register through the recreation department. #### Milton Fire Department

For the week ending 06/30/2019 the fire service has responded to 7 calls for service and have responded to 135 calls for service during 2019. Last week's responses included multiple fire alarms in the industrial park and two responses to the interstate for vehicle problems.

On 06/28/2019 the fire, rescue, and police departments responded to a motorcycle crash at the intersection of Middle Road and Railroad. The scene was cleaned up and no injuries or patient transports were reported.

With the Independence Day holiday fast approaching residents and visitors are reminded that fireworks are prohibited in the Town of Milton. Please contact the fire station if you have any questions.

On Tuesday, June 25<sup>th</sup>, more than 40 people stopped by the fire station to give blood, resulting in 32 units, exceeding the drive's goal. Please keep a look out for the next drive located at the fire station which will be scheduled for a Monday in October.
