Shall the voters of Milton Town School District approve the Milton Town School District Board of Trustees to expend thirty-nine million, two hundred ninety-one thousand, six hundred twenty-five dollars (\$39,291,625) which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? The Milton Town School District estimates that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in per pupil education spending of \$13,761.28 which is 3.27% higher than per pupil education spending for the current year.

The Milton Town School Board proposes to incur bonded indebtedness for the purpose of Facility Repair and Replacement to include Herrick Roof and Window Replacement; Electrical Code Compliance, and Library upgrades and improvements at the estimated total project cost of \$8,000,000. The School Construction Aid Program is currently under suspension by the Vermont State Legislature. Therefore, the 100% percent of the project shall be built at school district cost without State participation. **State funds may not be available at the time this project is otherwise eligible to receive State school construction aid. The district is responsible for all costs incurred in connection with any borrowing done in anticipation of State school construction aid.**
