### ARTICLE I:

Shall Milton Town School District appropriate the sum of Twenty One Million, six Hundred Sixty One Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Nine Dollars (\$21,661,889) for the support of the public schools for the school year commencing July 1, 2007?

### ARTICLE II:

Shall general obligation bonds or notes of Milton Town School District in an amount not to exceed One Million Five Hundred Three Thousand Sixty Five Dollars (\$1,503,065), subject to reduction from available state and/or federal construction grants-in-aid and appropriations (estimated to be \$450,920), be issued for the purpose of refunding the District's share of the cost incurred making certain public improvements, viz: the construction and installation of environmental remediation measures and water infiltration prevention measures at the Milton Elementary School, at a cost of One Million Five Hundred Three Thousand Sixty Five Dollars (\$1,503,065), the District's bonded indebtedness for such estimate to be One Million Fifty Two Thousand One Hundred Forty Five Dollars (\$1,052,145)?

### ARTICLE III:

Shall general obligation bonds or notes of Milton Town School District in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Twenty Six Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Eight Dollars (\$326,528), subject to reduction from available state and/or federal construction grants-in-aid and appropriations (estimated to be \$70,958), be issued for the purpose of financing the District's share of the cost of making certain public improvements, viz: the construction and installation of parking improvements at Milton Elementary School, elevator repairs at Milton Middle/High School, security and maintenance equipment to benefit both Milton Elementary School and Milton Middle/High School, the aggregate estimated cost of such improvements being Three Hundred Twenty Six Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Eight Dollars (\$326,528), and the District's bonded indebtedness for such estimate to be Two Hundred Fifty Five Thousand Five Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$255,570)?
