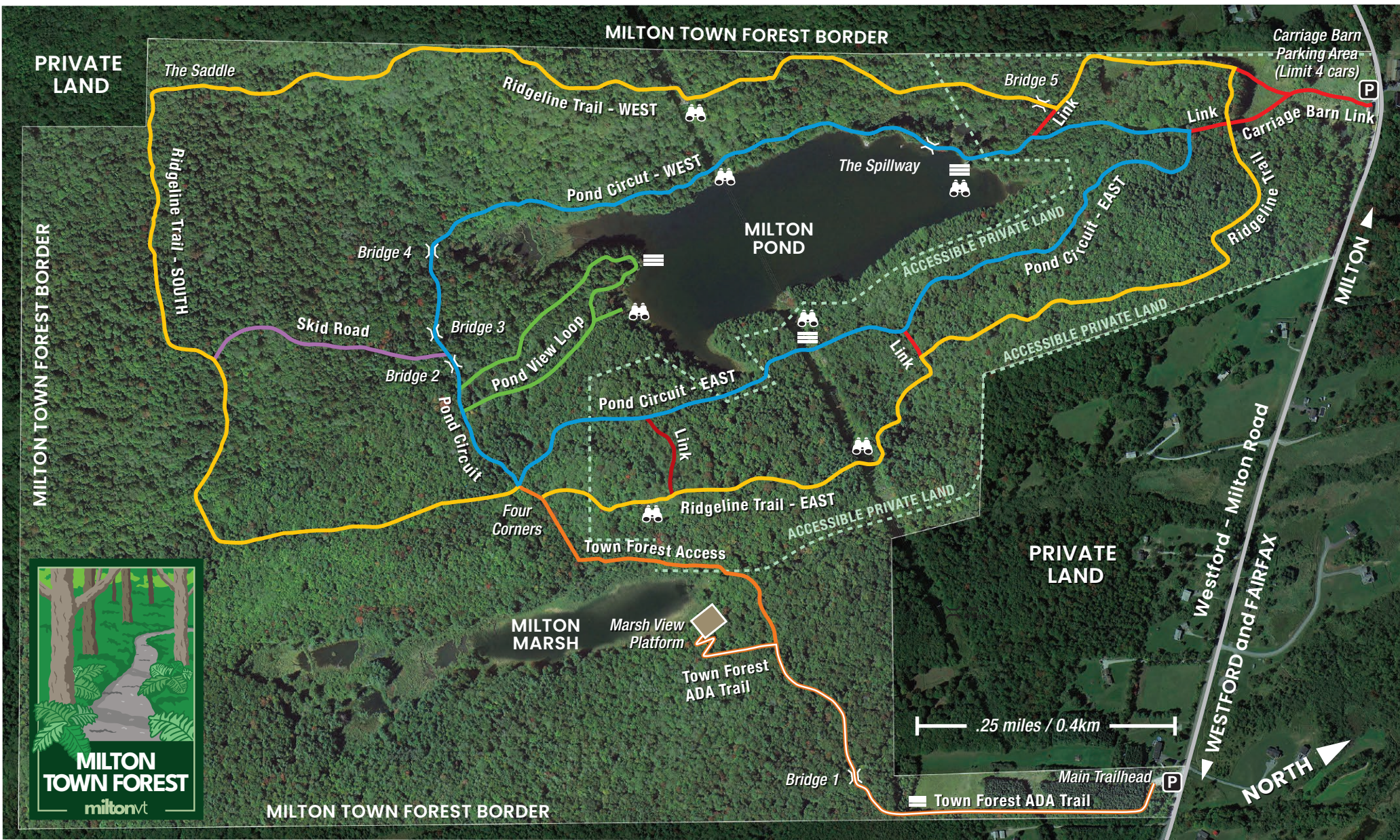

■ Town Forest ADA Trail (0.63 mi. / 1 km)

Wide, flat gravel path with some gentle inclines that terminate at a viewing platform with benches overlooking the Milton Marsh. This trail is designed to be ADA accessible for all levels of mobility, including strollers and wheelchair

■ Town Forest Access Trail (0.37 mi. / XX km)

Gentle downhill to a stream crossing, then near the marsh, use the dry bypass to avoid muddy conditions and turn right for a steady climb up to the trail junction at Four Corners.

■ Ridgeline Trail (3.3 mi. / 5.3 km)

From the Forest Access Trail climb to Four Corners and take Ridgeline South, climbing to The Saddle. Ridgeline West then descends steadily, emerging high above Milton Pond, then descending to the Northern end before turning East. Taking Ridgeline East there is up and down terrain reaching a scenic overlook ledge with views toward Mt. Mansfield before descending to the Forest Access Trail and the Pond Circuit Trail at Four Corners. Take the Town Forest Access trail from the Four Corners to return to the main trailhead parking lot.

■ Pond Circuit (2.25 mi. / 3.6 km)

Forms a full loop around Milton Pond. Pond Circuit East has some challenging terrain, with short, steep climbs and descents through coniferous and deciduous forest. Pond Circuit South is mostly flat that slopes gently west, crossing three foot bridges and access to the Pond View Loop and Skid Road Trails. Pond Circuit West skirts the Milton Pond shoreline, with several viewpoints and Link Trails to Ridgeline West and the Carriage Barn parking.

■ Pond View Loop (0.5 mi / 0.8 km)

Loop trail with a gentle section out to a peninsula overlooking Milton Pond, then returning through mixed forest.

■ Skid Road Trail (0.25 mi / 0.4 km)

Short, fairly steep trail linking Ridgeline South and Pond Circuit South sections

■ Link Trails — Various lengths

Short connector trails linking main routes and the Carriage Barn Parking Area (max 4 vehicles).
